



ST. PATRICK PRE-SCHOOL

- 5 star rating according to the Iowa Quality Rating System. It is the highest possible score. St. Patrick has the only 5 star rating in Jones County
- 8 students for every one adult.
- 4 year old pre-school is free through the volunteer pre-school grant.
- Jones County Empowerment Grant for our 3 year old pre-school program.
- There is an afternoon, morning, and all day option for 4 year olds.
- Ideas and feelings are explored through creative play, drama, dance and movement, music, art, and construction.
- Children learn to communicate effectively, become good problem solvers, and develop positive friendships.
- Experiences will be provided that meet your child's individual needs.

School Tuition Organization

- The STO gives any family, whether they are Catholic or not, an opportunity to get a Catholic education that may not be able to afford it.
- The STO offers tuition assistance to families based upon their identified financial need and the amount of money available in the program.
- Those families whose income is at or below 300% of the federal poverty level qualify for assistance through this program.
- The STO has provided nearly 12,000 grants to qualifying students.

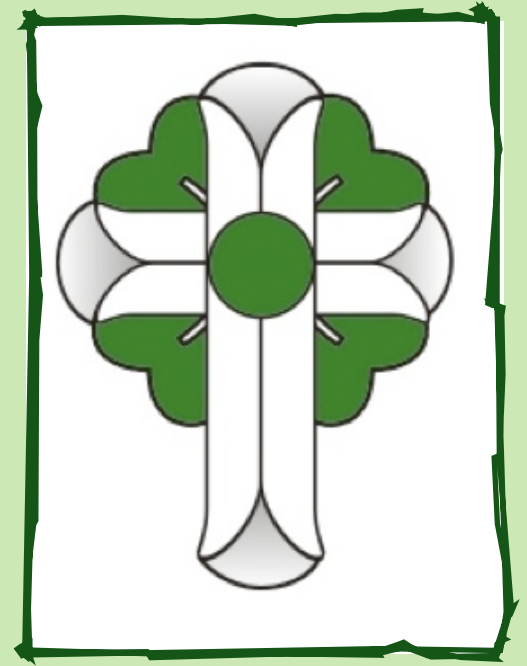


SCHOOL TUITION (2010-2011)
