Labels for Education

Check out this revised and improved program to help support schools! Several new partners have been added such as Post Cereals, Pop-Secret, and BIC.

For more than 30 years, Labels for Education (formerly Campbell's Labels for Education) has been awarding free educational equipment to schools in exchange for proofs of purchase. It's a fun, easy program where students, families and members of the community work together for a common goal.

To participate in this program and help the school, simply look for the "Proof of Purchase" barcode on eligible products you use. Clip and keep the part of the label where the bar code is (It usually says EARN FREE STUFF FOR YOUR SCHOOL! Sometimes it shows the picture of a child holding a pencil, and lists the point value). Every now and then, bring the clipped "Proof of Purchase" barcode labels to the school and drop them off at the front desk.
